Welcome back - the beginning of a brand new school year and a fresh start for all. A special welcome to Reception children and their families and the new pupils who have started with us. Welcome also to the new staff members including Mrs Dearden who will be teaching in YR 3 and YR 1, one day a week, Miss Barnes who will be teaching YR2 and Miss Preston who will be teaching YR5.

School was a hive of activity throughout the summer, and you will hopefully notice some positive changes when you walk through the gate! New signage and playground markings have improved the outside and our new school logo is now painted on the wall at the front of the hall. Thank you to Mr Turner for doing this - it looks fabulous. Staff have been busy preparing classrooms, and have very much enjoyed meeting their new classes this week. Staff and Governors have agreed on our priorities for school improvement. Our main priorities are:-

1. To accelerate achievement in maths across the school
2. To accelerate achievement in phonics and reading across the school
3. To accelerate achievement in writing across the school
4. To develop the children's role in regularly planning, leading and evaluating collective worship
5. To develop the leadership and staff team; building confidence to create a shared vision with defined roles and responsibilities

We are focussing on accelerating achievement in key curriculum areas, and the senior leadership team and Governors will meet regularly to monitor the progress of all children in school. Teachers will keep parents informed of ways they can support their children. Your opinions and ongoing support have been very much appreciated. The parents' questionnaires that were sent out at the end of last term were analysed by one of our Governors and were overwhelmingly positive. A copy of the analysis is available on the notice board inside the entrance hall. Staff and Governors have celebrated strengths and considered all suggestions for improvement. Pupil questionnaires were also analysed and contributions from all stakeholders have been valued and added to the school improvement plan.

First Parents Evening

The first parents evening of the year will be on the 26th September. This is an early opportunity for parents to meet new teachers, and discuss how your child has settled into their new class. You can also

share any concerns and pass on any useful information. Signing in sheets will be available in the entrance hall from next Friday 15th September.

Uniform

The children have all returned to school looking smart. Our uniform is now available sporting our new logo; however, uniform displaying the old logo can be worn until Easter next year. The new PE kit is proving very popular and looks fantastic. Please ensure all children have a waterproof coat with them as the weather is turning wintery.
