



Pennington CE Primary School KS2 Assessment Results 2015

One measure which the Department for Education uses is the percentage of pupils attaining Level 4 (the broad, nationally-expected level for 11 year olds) or more by the end of Year 6 in both English and Maths.

Pennington School Performance Outcomes for KS2 July 2015:

Subject Areas:	% of Pupils Attaining Level 4+	% of Pupils Attaining Level 5+
Reading	90%	53%
Writing	93%	7%
Maths	90%	23%

Progress between KS1 and KS2 (July 2015)

- Progress is typically measured from Year 2 (the end of Key Stage 1) to Year 6 (the end of Key Stage 2). The percentage of pupils at Pennington CE School who improved by 2 or more levels in Reading, Writing and Maths between Key Stage 1 (KS1) and Key Stage 2 (KS2) are as follows:

Maths	97%
